



Public Health Notifications Expected Benzo Fentanyl Date & Location **Drugs Detected** What does this mean? Drug Strip Strip Down 29 April 2020- OPS, Vancouver Caffeine, mannitol (sweetener) Positive Positive Check for benzos in your drugs at any OPS/SCS (fentanyl) Down 28 April 2020- Get Your Drugs Caffeine, mannitol (sweetener) Positive Positive Benzos can cause prolonged ODs Tested, Vancouver (fentanyl) Caffeine, erythritol (sweetener), Carfentanil is an extremely strong opioid; start slowly and 23 April, 2020- OPS, Vancouver sucrose (sugar), fentanyl or analog, Positive Positive don't use alone! possible carfentanil Caffeine, erythritol (sweetener), 22 April 2020- OPS, Vancouver Down Positive Positive Combining benzos and opioids can worsen OD symptoms acorbic acid Caffeine, erythritol (sweetener), Benzo OD symproms may continue after 22 April 2020- OPS, Vancouver Positive Positive sucrose (sugar), fentanyl or analog Naloxone is given 18.1% of expected opioid samples tested positive for benzodiazepines in the Vancouver Coastal Health Region region

This report summarizes key indicators for Fourier Transform Infrared (FTIR)/fentanyl test strip combination drug checking done in Vancouver Coastal Health in April 2020.

As there is 5% fentanyl detection limit on the Bruker ALPHA Fourier-Transform Infrared (FTIR) spectrometer (McCrae, 2019), a drug check on any given sample consists of both the FTIR and BTNX fentanyl immunoassay test strip testing done in combination. When applicable, BTNX benzodiazepine or lysergic acid diethylamide (LSD) immunoassay test strips are also used.

Benzodiazepine-positivity of opioid samples are determined using BTNX benzodiazeoine test strips, which have not been formally evaluated for drug checking. Therefore, the results presented above are presumptive and tentative until confirmed by a laboratory.

* "Fentanyl not tested" means that a fentanyl test stip wasn't done for the sample because the client declined to do the test, or they left before the test was able to be completed.





Psychedelic may include: 2C-family, tryptamines, ketamine, MDMA, LSD, cannabis Stimulant may include: "speed", crystal meth, cocaine. cathinones Unknown includes: all samples in which the client could not identify the expected substance
