

Key Findings


- The percentage of opioids testing positive for benzodiazepines (24%, 81 of 337 samples) rose slightly from last month to the second highest level since the start of the project. Etizolam, the predominant benzodiazepine in expected opioids, may be missed by drug checking technologies. This means that the true rate may be higher than reported here.
- 7 depressant samples (5 alprazolam/Xanax, 1 flubromazepam, 1 xylazine) and 3 stimulant samples (1 cocaine & 2 methamphetamine) tested positive for fentanyl this month.
- A large number of MDMA samples were checked leading up to New Year's Eve—two of which tested positive for fentanyl. One of these samples also appeared to contain shards of glass. It cannot be determined if these adulterants were added in before purchase or were result of accidental cross contamination or other factors.
- Benzodiazepines confirmed in expected opioid samples in the last 3 months included etizolam, flualprazolam, flubromazolam, norfludiazepam, and clonazolam. These are all potent unregulated benzodiazepines.
- · Novel opioids detected by confirmatory testing in November include para-fluorofentanyl, para-bromofentanyl, carfentanil, and metonitazene.











Number of samples tested with fentanyl present






During the month of December, **24.0**% of expected opioid samples tested positive for benzodiazepines using test strips in our partner sites in Vancouver Coastal Health (**81 samples of 337 checked**). Opioid samples are checked for benzodiazepine-positivity using BTNX test strips and the FTIR spectrometer. The results presented here are derived from both of these technologies and are presumptive until confirmed by a laboratory.

Data represented here are collected from our partner sites across the province. Drug samples are tested using the Fourier Transform Infrared (FTIR) spectrometer in combination with fentanyl test strips and benzodiazapine test strips.

There is 5% fentanyl detection limit on the FTIR spectrometer (McCrae, 2019), and a drug check on any given sample consists of <u>both</u> the FTIR <u>and</u> BTNX fentanyl immunoassay test strip testing done in combination. When applicable, BTNX benzodiazepine immunoassay test strips are also used.
