

# **Program Evaluation Guidance & Considerations**

Evaluations can be a helpful tool to assess the effectiveness of drug checking services and identify areas for improvement. While systematic evaluation approaches can provide a comprehensive understanding of the service delivery model's performance and impact, informal evaluation methods may also be sufficient to achieve your goals and measure outcomes. Below are some considerations for planning a community-based evaluation:

# 1. Define Objectives and Goals of the Drug Checking Service Model

- Purpose: Why are you evaluating the service model (e.g., improve service delivery, assess reach, understand impact)?
- Set Objectives: What do you hope to achieve with this evaluation? (e.g., identify who we are reaching and how, measure changes in knowledge/behaviour)

#### 3. Data Collection

- **Methods:** Decide how you will collect data on the above indicators (e.g., surveys, service records/database).
- Frequency: Decide how often you will gather this data (e.g., monthly, semi annually)

## 2. Determine Evaluation Criteria

- Outcome Measures: Define what successful outcomes of the outreach service look like (e.g., increased access to drug checking [target population]).
- Key Performance Indicators: Based on the outcomes, choose metrics to track whether they are being achieved (e.g., # of samples collected, service user satisfaction).

## 4. Analyze Data

- **Data Analysis:** Organize and process the information you've gathered
- Interpret Results: compare the result to the outcomes and key performance indicators you established at the start.
